Toward 2030, we will continue to promote consideration for biodiversity centered on operational sites, utilization of Canon technologies and products, and contribution to the realization of a community.

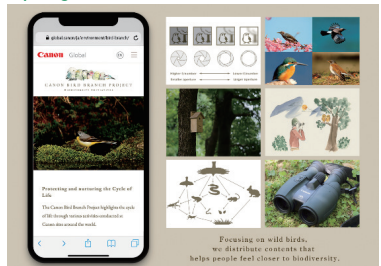
