Procurement with consideration for conserving for ecosystems

Taikisha selects office supplies for its construction site offices from among the carbon offset applicable items to consider for conserving forest ecosystems. Plant Factory Business Initiatives

Amid the growing need for safe and reliable vegetable production, Taikisha is developing its plant factory business using only artificial lighting based on its strengths in air-conditioning technologies.

Vegetable production in a plant factory has the benefit of being able to grow vegetables in a cleaner environment and more systematically (in a given period of time/constant amount/constant quality/stable price) than in open-field cultivation. Other benefits from the viewpoint of conserving biodiversity and ecosystems are that plant factories, which are closed cultivation systems free from pests and fungi, can produce vegetables without the use of agrochemicals, and significantly reduce the water wash process.
