



Policy for the future:

Sumitomo Chemical's Commitment to the Conservation of Biodiversity was established in 2011 and states: "We position the conservation of biodiversity as one of our most important management issues and strive to help protect the global environment." The Company promotes its own initiatives to help reduce environmental impact. In one such instance, since 2008 a total of 150 employees have helped plant 553,000 mangrove saplings in the Sumitomo Chemical Forest, which is a mangrove planting project spanning 195 hectares in southern Thailand. We are carrying out various initiatives with care, for example, establishing and steadily implementing internal rules in compliance with the Cartagena Protocol. Going forward, we will continue to promote the conservation of biodiversity in part by further expanding our lineup of eco-friendly certified products.
