Policy for the future:

Climate change is inseparably linked to biodiversity, as the changes in environment due to global warming would have negative impacts on biological system. The LIAJ will make efforts on biodiversity conservation mainly through:

- 1. Sharing intelligences with life insurance companies on climate change
- 2. Reduction of greenhouse gas emission, by setting environmental conservation target, making industry-wide efforts for reduction of electricity consumption and efficient use of electricity.

The LIAJ published a starter's guide for addressing climate change.





2. Efforts on reduction of greenhouse gas emission

The LIAJ has been trying every year to reduce electricity consumption per floor area.





The target from FY2020 to FY2030 is to reduce of the entire company (its headquarters, branches, sales offices and etc.) to below the target level for FY2020, which was to reduce it by an average of 1% per year compared to FY2009.
