We made a commitment to tackling the biodiversity issue in the CSR guideline established in 2009, and started the Sanyo Chemical Woodland Project in the same year. In 2013, we established our Action Policy Concerning Biodiversity that set the policies for how we conduct business in research and development, procurement, and production by giving consideration to biodiversity, improving employees' biodiversity preservation awareness, and tackling the biodiversity issue in cooperation with local communities. We have been conducting activities in accordance with this policy.

The Sanyo Chemical Woodland Project in Wazuka Town, Souraku-gun, Kyoto Prefecture, aims to “foster a spirit of respect for nature”. We raise awareness about biodiversity besides forestry activities with employee volunteers.
