In addition, we collaborate with local communities to maintain forests and exterminate invasive alien species at each of our global business sites.

Creating Environmentally Friendly Business Facilities

We aim to create an ecological facility with a humanistic spatial composition and harmony with the natural environment.

●Y-TOWN (Gotemba, Shizuoka)

In Y-TOWN*, trees of local origin are planted and a landscaping pond is placed to create a forest in harmony with the landscape of the land.

*Y-TOWN (Gotemba, Shizuoka) is a welfare facility consisting of company housing, dormitories and other facilities that emphasize the relationship with nature, the community and people.

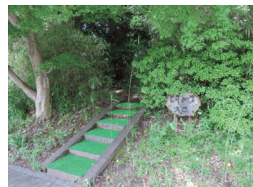

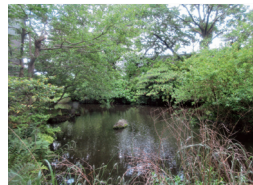
●Y-CITY (Susono, Shizuoka)

At Y-CITY*, we have created a tree forest that utilizes existing tree species and a waterfront biotope based on the concept of “environmentally friendly coexistence with nature”.

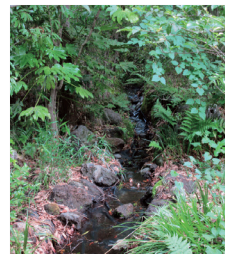
*Y-CITY (Susono, Shizuoka) is an information base where the Yazaki Group’s headquarter functions are gathered and information is deployed globally.
