## Policy for the future:

The Nisshin OilliO Group's business activities are based on plant resources; therefore, the very sustainability of our business relies on conserving the global environment and natural capital. We import our main raw materials—soybean, rapeseed, palm oil, cacao, olive oil, and sesame—from all over the world, and thus depend on certain natural capital and specific production areas. We also recognize that our business activities impact natural capital in the value chain. Therefore, in accordance with The Nisshin OilliO Group Biodiversity Policy, we will earnestly work toward solutions for conserving natural capital through our business activities in an effort to create shared value with society and achieve the sustainable growth of the Group and the sustainable advancement of society.

Regarding palm oil, which accounts for approximately 25% of our Group's sales, we will explain our efforts to procure sustainable palm oil that takes biodiversity into consideration.

## Understanding traceability in palm oil procurement and promoting action plans to resolve issues: a example of initiatives

 Protecting forests and respecting human rights by improving productivity and profitability of small-scale farmers

Our group has started supporting small-scale farmers to obtain RSPO certification together with European chocolate company Ferrero and our group's main sourcing farm Hap Seng. We provide free technical assistance (training, construction of training facilities, etc.) to help small-scale farmers obtain RSPO certification. In 2024, we supported four smallholder farmers and recognized the importance of working across the entire value chain to achieve sustainable palm oil sourcing. We plan to expand our efforts in 2025.
