The “Satochi Satoyama project”, surrounding main office has started from 2009. Preserving and regenerating devastated Satoyama to restore the beautiful landscape of Musashino region.

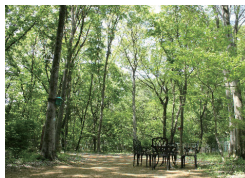
In 2011, we obtained the highest ranking “AAA” of the JHEP certification of Ecosystem Conservation Society Japan and in 2017 also obtained the same rank of the certification. We continue to maintain Satoyama forests looking 50 years ahead. This continual maintenance bore fruit that 8 species of near-threatened orchids in Saitama Prefecture have been identified at present.

In 2013, we were certified as “the place of opportunity of experience” based on the Act on the Promotion of Environmental Conservation Activities through Environmental Education. In 2019, more than 40,000 people visited from around the world. The “3R Classroom”, which think about SDGs during industrial waste recycling factory tours, and the “Nature Experience program” of Santome Shinden are used by many companies and organizations, including schools.
