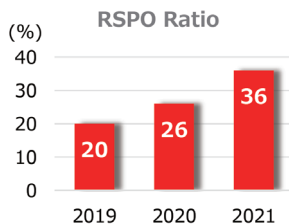
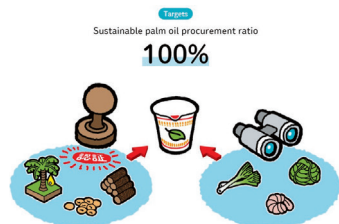

■ Procurement of Sustainable Palm Oil

The NISSHIN FOODS Group set a goal to raise the procurement rate for palm oil that is assessed to be sustainable to 100% for the entire group by FY2031. To comply with the “zero deforestation” policy, we also ensure traceability of our oil mills and analyze deforestation risks with the satellite monitoring system.



< Future Challenges >

- Conduct biodiversity impact assessments of our major operations
- Reduce the environmental impact of raw materials by increasing the proportion of plant-based ingredients and utilizing upcycled food
- Restore biodiversity in our operational areas through reforestation and sustainable farming
