4. We will share appropriate information about our biodiversity initiatives.

◆NIPPN Shikinomori Forest

From 2011 to 2022, we had maintained wastelands and planted trees in Fukagawa city, Hokkaido. We continue to implement ecosystem conservation activities through trees care and management.



◆Tomato harvesting experience

Our group company, NAGANO TOMATO Co., Ltd. promotes local production for local consumption of raw materials. Every summer, our new employees are given the opportunity to rediscover the importance of nature's blessings through the experience of harvesting tomatoes.



◆Use of paper trays made from certified forest raw materials

For the purpose of plastic reduction and forest conservation, we have been using PEFC-certified paper trays for some of our frozen pasta products since 2003.
