Policy for the future:



The Yamanashi Chuo Bank Group, as a financial group based in Yamanashi Prefecture, which is blessed with abundant water resources and where approximately 80% of the prefecture is covered by forests, has an important social responsibility to pass on our rich natural environment to future generations.

Under this recognition, we will actively work to resolve environmental issues such as climate change and biodiversity conservation, and contribute to the realization of sustainable local communities.

"Yamanashi Chugin Fureai no Satoyama" (since 2011)

Yamanashi Chuo Bank addresses "maintaining our rich natural environment and passing it on to the future" as one of the material issues.

As part of our efforts to resolve this issue, we have promoted conservation of Japanese traditional rural area, which we call "Satochi-Satoyama", where people and nature live in harmony, and as an activity to pass on to future generations, we also have worked to preserve abandoned cultivated land and forests under the guidance of local farmers and forestry associations, and to grow a variety of vegetables on revived farmland.

We also cleared the adjacent degraded forest and planted trees.



We started to donate postage costs saved by exercising voting rights online at General Shareholders' Meetings to local tree-planting activities (since 2023)

In order to work together with shareholders to protect the local nature environment, Yamanashi Chuo Bank will donate postage costs saved by exercising voting rights online at General Shareholders' Meeting plus 200,000yen to NPOs that protect the natural environment.

In 2023, we donated 260,000yen (equivalent to 52 hardwood trees)

Eco-friendly passbook case (since 2021)

The material of the passbook case has been changed from conventional polyethylene to material containing biomass.
